Who are informal or family carers?

Informal or family carers are considered to be those who provide care to people with a chronic illness or disability or age-related support without receiving any payment.

These people carry out important care work and, although this can offer personal satisfaction for many, it involves several challenges.

What are the objectives of the project?

With the cooperation of partners from Greece, Belgium, France and Ireland, the “Learning for Caregivers in Europe (Learn4Carers)” project has the following objectives:

- 1 Exchange of experiences and good practices to support informal or family carers
- 2 Strengthening mutual learning among organisations in relation to support services for informal carers
- 3 Informing professionals providing support services to informal carers
- 4 Raise European citizens’ awareness of the challenges faced by informal carers
- 5 Developing proposals at both local and European level to support informal carers

Activities of the project include:

- ▶ Transnational meetings in Athens (02.19), Dublin (09.19), Brussels (02.20) and Paris (10/20)
- ▶ Focus groups with family carers, professionals and policymakers
