# Who are informal or family carers?

Informal or family carers are considered to be those who provide care to people with a chronic illness or disability or age-related support without receiving any payment.

These people carry out important care work and, although this can offer personal satisfaction for many, it involves several challenges.

# What are the objectives of the project?

With the cooperation of partners from Greece, Belgium, France and Ireland, the "Learning for Caregivers in Europe (Learn4Carers)" project has the following objectives:

- Exchange of experiences and good practices to support informal or family carers
- Strengthening mutual learning among organisations in relation to support services for informal carers
- Informing professionals providing support services to informal carers
- Raise European citizens' awareness of the challenges faced by informal carers
- Developing proposals at both local and European level to support informal carers
